How to Register and Complete the Training

1. Complete this form and submit to Katie Gorrell at Paulding County OSU Extension Office @ Gorrell.42@osu.edu.
2. Remit Payment of \$150.00 Payable to: OSU Extension @ 503 Fairground Drive; Paulding OH 45879
3. You will receive 2 emails messages. One email will come from TAP and one email will come from OSU Extension and will include your username/password and additional class information which will allow you access the online class.
4. Complete the online class and print Certificate of Completion. (This will take 2-4 weeks.)
5. Before or on the exam date, deliver a copy of the Certificate of Completion to Paulding County OSU Extension Office indicating successful completion of the online TAP course. (Certificate may be hand delivered, mailed or emailed.)
6. Upon passing the exam, you will be presented with a ServSafe certificate which may be printed at www.ServeSafe.com.
7. Upon passing the exam, you must complete an "Application for Reciprocity of Ohio Department of Health's Certification in Food Protection Form" found at: http://go.osu.edu/reciprocity_level2foodsafety.
 - On this form, supply name of course (TAP) & hours spent on course material (minimum is 15 hrs.)
 - Supply copy of certificate from ServSafe showing successful completion of exam.
